CAMP FEES:

All unpaid fees are due before check-in at camp. If you registered online, your remaining funds will be auto-drafted 3 days before camp on June 30, 2019. Any cancellations must be made at least 1 week prior to camp (6/25/19) to receive a refund. Any cancellations after this time will be charged the full non-refundable deposit (\$150). Cancellations must email stolson@fca.org.

MEAL CARD/ROOM KEY: lost keys will cost the camper \$100. This is a university policy and charge that the dorm will collect at check-out on Wednesday if not returned.

PARKING PASS: If a student is planning to drive themselves and park a vehicle for the duration of camp, you must notify the Camp Director, cmcinturff@fca.org, by June 28, 2019. Detailed directions for obtaining parking pass will be given at that time.

WHAT TO BRING:

Modest clothing is required at all times during camp. Game equipment such as balls will be provided, but you will need to bring plenty of athletic clothes/sports attire and personal equipment for your selected sport (shoes/cleats, knee pads, gloves, etc.), and a daily change of clothes for evening sessions.

Additionally, make sure to bring:

- Journal and Pen
- Personal Toiletries & Towel
- Bedding (sleeping bag or sheets/blanket & pillow for twin sized bed)
- Extra spending money for camp store
- You may bring snacks & water for your room
- Backpack, sunscreen, water bottle
- Alarm clock

PLEASE DO NOT BRING:

- Jewelry or other expensive items
- AirPods, Beats, headphones, electronic games, TVs or radios
- NO pets of any kind.
- NO ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREARMS OR WEAPONS ARE ALLOWED AT ANYTIME ON CAMPUS.

Cell phones **are allowed**, but will be collected periodically throughout the week to eliminate distractions during meetings.

Directions: Corps of Cadets dorms are located near the campus golf course on the east side of campus. FCA signs will be clearly visible pointing you to the registration area.

- If coming from Texas Ave., turn onto George Bush Drive towards the University. You will then turn right on Coke Street. Parking will be available in lot 40. Please park and unload there.
- If coming from Wellborn Drive, Turn onto George Bush Drive towards main campus (away from athletic facilities). You will then turn left onto Coke Street.

PARKING

- Parking will be available in lot 40. Please park and unload there.

Please note: there is not a loading/unloading zone available. You will be ticketed or towed if you choose to park elsewhere.

DEPARTURE:

Camp ends at **11:00am, Wednesday, 7/3/19.**

Check-out will be at Corps of Cadets dorms (Same as check-in).

The final camp meal will be breakfast on Wednesday, July 3rd.

INSURANCE:

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide a proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. A photocopy of your insurance card will be sufficient. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

MEDICINE:

All medicines (including over the counter pain relief like Tylenol etc.) must be turned in to the Camp Nurse/Athletic Trainers upon check-in and will be administered as needed. Refrigeration will be available as needed.

FCA SWAG:

All campers will receive a camp t-shirt, lanyard, nametag and Bible at check-in. If you would like to purchase anything extra – we will have all the swag you could ever dream of in the camp store! Make sure to bring some extra cash if you want to shop FCA!
